The First Five Women drivers all Set to take off

The first phase of the electric auto project under FCDP is all ready to launch. The project undertaken in collaboration with Don Bosco (Breads) create Bangalore, aims to new employment opportunities and a steady income for women, ensure gender equality, as well as to reduce urban pollution besides raising environmental A number of women awareness. belonging to the coastal areas from Thangassery to Thanni have already undergone training for e-autos. Through the electric auto project FCDP proposes to provide 32 e-auto Rikshaws to the women trainees in the coming years. It will provide a total of 15 electric auto-rickshaws in the first year, five being distributed at the first phase. This project is also a participatory venture as the members of the scheme contribute a monthly sum of Rs. 6250/- for a year towards the project as rental charge. The e-autos will be made available to



the women, on completion of the first year at a discount price. The project is executed also in collaboration with Mahindra Automobiles, Bangalore who have agreed to support the project by way of price and facilities.
