glad to be a part of the session. The programme ended with a feedback session by the participants who thanked Mr. Rajesh for the interactive, entertaining and informative session, followed by a vote of thanks by Ms. Ansona (DBYF member).

# Training for Women drivers





A training program was conducted for the women drivers at Mahindra Service centre, Madanada, under the WE-AUTO project. The session was led by Mr. Jamin, Technical manager and Mr. Jithin, Asst. Service manager.

Mr. Jamin gave general guidelines with regard to charging, maintenance of battery, need to drain the battery before the next charging, the need to have a circuit braker in case of power variations, importance of charging the vehicle continuously for 8 hours in every four days. He explained the do's and don'ts while driving an electric vehicle. After the session the drivers were given opportunity to clarify their doubts given that the participants have been using own vehicles for some time.

The participants were concerned about the maximum load that can be carried vehicle and high battery consumption in such cases. Concerns were also raised about charging throughout the night. The training programme was attended by Sabeena, Ms. Seena, Ms. Mary, Ms. Sunitha, Ms. Manju - the beneficiaries of the first phase of the We-auto project and Ms. Shiny, the driver of 'Vishappinu Vida' E-auto. The programme was facilitated by Ms. Anjali Joseph , Project Coordinator, WE-AUTO.
