The keys were handed over to Mrs. Shajitha and Mrs. Jaya Roy. Till now, FCDP has provided 17 electric autos to coastal women.

The We-auto project proposes to provide 32 e-autos for women in an effort to overcome gender stereotypes and make women earning members of families. It is inspiring to note that the women beneficiaries are earning between Rs. 20,000 to Rs. 45,000 per month.
